We Welcome the announcement that most restrictions are ending and that Ireland is entering a new phase of dealing with Covid.

Accordingly, as of now, the following apply to all Churches.

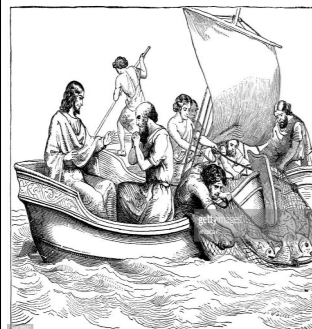
1. Face masks should continue to be worn at all times in churches.
2. Hand sanitiser should continue to be made available at the doors of churches.
3. Social distancing no longer applies in churches. Seats should not be cordoned off, seats that were removed can be returned and people can approach communion as before restrictions were imposed.
4. For the present, Holy Communion should continue to be administered on the hand. The Episcopal Conference, which imposed this restriction, will revisit this issue at their next meeting.
5. Holy Water may be used in the fonts at church doors.

Vocation Notice

Jesus steps into the lives of the disciples to make them agents of God's presence in the world (cf. Lk 5:1-11). Peter is dejected because the fishermen's work produced no catch. At the word of Christ, their nets fill to breaking point. Peter had put his faith in this "Master" that spoke with authority. He says, "At your word, I will let down the nets" (Lk 5:5). After the miracle, he calls him "Lord." This calling of the disciples tells us that the Lord asks every vocation to the Priesthood to fill the nets of the Church with souls who know him.
