## Fifth Sunday of Lent

Meister Echart said that: "The sinner of today is the saint of tomorrow. What is a saint, after all other than a forgiven sinner. The logic of the kingdom of God teaches that the more we have been forgiven, the more we love; the less we have been forgiven, the less we love (Luke 7:47).

The Holy Spirit can enlighten our hearts and minds so that we grasp or touch something of the depth of God's mercy and forgiveness. For it is in knowing God's forgiveness that we can forgive, and in experiencing God's mercy that we can be merciful.

This story which is very unique to John the Evangelist seeks to underscore the unique role and mission of Jesus as the one with power to forgive and save; the one who destroys sin but saves the sinner and becomes the path to our redemption and life in God.

This gives us an insight into the radical nature of God's forgiveness: it is all-embracing and abundant that no one is beyond redemption and that every sin can be forgiven. Our own judgment of others must reflect the infinite mercy of God revealed to us in Christ Jesus.

> O Lord Jesus, may we hear your voice telling us to move on and sin no more. Amen.

Pope Francis' Apostolic Exhortation Christus vivit (Christ is Alive):

**Orla Walsh** will speak about faith and family during Holy Thursday's Mass of the Last Supper at 7:30pm. Orla is a married woman, mother of three teenage children, who is the vice principal of Mount Sackville Girls Secondary School in Dublin. Orla will talk about how we can nourish, support and faith more closely.

To respond to our vocation, we need to foster and develop all that we are. This has nothing to do with inventing ourselves or creating ourselves out of nothing. It has to do with finding our true selves in the light of God and letting our lives flourish and bear fruit (CV 259). We let ourselves be transformed by Christ, even as we develop "the habit of doing good, which also is a part of our examination of conscience. We do not simply identify sins, but also recognize God's work in our daily lives, in the events of our personal history and the world around us, and in the witness of all those men and enrich families in following their Catholic II women who have gone before us or accompany us with their wisdom. This helps us to grow in the virtue of prudence and to give an overall direction to our life through concrete choices, in the serene awareness of both our gifts and our limitations" (CV 282).
