

Advent 2018: Sacrament of Reconciliation and online Advent Calendar

The Irish Bishops said, "The call to renewal of our Christian life is a central part of our preparation for the season of Christmas. Our celebration of Advent should be an integral part of our preparation for the Feast of the birth of Our Saviour.

In the Sacrament of Reconciliation (or Penance), we receive the gift of God's mercy and forgiveness. We encourage all Catholics to make time during the season of Advent to celebrate and receive the gift of God's love in the Sacrament of Reconciliation."

As a unique Advent prayerful resource, the Bishops' Conference has provided its interactive online Advent calendar which can be enjoyed by people of all ages. In its fifth year of publication, the Advent calendar is available on the home page of www.catholicbishops.ie.

The calendar focuses on the theme of family as we reflect together on this year's World Meeting of Families and visit of Pope Francis. Each day during Advent the faithful are invited to click open a virtual door where faith content for family, school and parish can be found.

During Advent, families are invited to take special time together to pray, to talk, and to be together. Family members are encouraged to undertake an act of kindness or charity – as suggested by the daily calendar – and in doing so to reach out to help those around us.

Abortion cannot be supported

Reflecting on the current Dáil debate on the abortion bill the Irish bishops said, "We are dismayed that, for the most part, the voices of those who voted against abortion in May's referendum have been ignored.

"As we stated after our Autumn Meeting, Irish society must have respect for the right of conscientious objection for all healthcare professionals and pharmacists. They cannot be forced either to participate in abortion or to refer patients to others for abortion.

"Every one of us has a right to life. It is not given to us by the Constitution of Ireland or by any law. We have it 'as of right', whether we are wealthy or poor, healthy or sick. All human beings have it. The direct and intentional taking of human life at any stage is gravely wrong and can never be justified.

"Women's lives, and the lives of their unborn children, are precious, valued and always deserving of protection. Any law which suggests otherwise would have no moral force. In good conscience it cannot be supported and would have to be resisted.

History of the Peace Light:

In December each year a candle lit in the Grotto of Christ's birth in the church of the Nativity in Bethlehem is collected by Scouting Ireland in Holyhead and brought to Dublin.

The 14th Louth St Martins will distribute the peace light from Bethlehem at all the Masses on Sunday 23rd December here in St Mary's Church and anyone wishing to take a light from it are asked to bring a lantern with them. This chain of light is a symbol of peace, warmth, love and family.

This year the light will shine in places where the significance of what it symbolises, in other words peace in many countries where Christians are being persecuted for their faith. A youth member will speak at the Masses
