We are delighted to welcome you back to Mass as our Churches reopen for public worship. The resumption of public worship is a source of great joy and gratitude to so many who have patiently awaited the opportunity to participate in the celebration of the Eucharist and the Sacraments. We thank you for your continued support and prayers throughout lockdown. We are indebted and humbled by the generosity of those who financially supported the parish in difficult times. Sadly many families carry the burden of the loss of loved one from Covid, and of the heavy price which has had to be paid in terms of jobs and incomes, as well as significant impact on the mental wellbeing of young and old.

While the pandemic continues to dominate the news, there are great signs of hope as we freely gather around the Lord's table. Pope Francis has encouraged daily recitation of the Rosary during the month of May in light of the global crisis posed by the virus. Let us commend our Parish and our families to the protection of Our Blessed Mother as we journey through the challenging months ahead. In the weeks and months ahead, let us renew our commitment to building and strengthening our faith community where people feel welcomed and assured.

While many are familiar with the procedures in place prior to lockdown, it would greatly help our stewards if worshippers renew their commitment to following the guidelines below:

- In Line with public health norms, those attending Mass should wear a face covering in the church and use the hand sanitisers provided at the entrances and exits to the church.
- Social distancing norms limit the number of people allowed to enter the churches at any one time. The church is divided into 3 pods with a maximum of 50 people per pod.
- → In light of the above directives, we would ask parishioners not to gather inside/outside the church.

Fr. Phil Our Parish Priest appointed Administrator of the Cathedral in Mullingar.



These Diocesan changes will take effect on 3rd July 2021.

Funeral Masses - Given public health concerns about the increased risk of transmission of the virus where families and communities come together following the death of a loved one, the following procedures are in place in compliance with government norms:

- The number permitted to attend Funeral masses is capped at 50 regardless of the size of the church.
- Funeral Masses will be live-streamed to facilitate those unable to attend.

Offertory Collection - In line with public health advice, the collection baskets will no longer be passed among the congregation during Masses; supervised collection baskets will be available at the church doors. Also, you can use the donate button on our parish website.
