Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The first reading from the prophet leremiah presents the image of the flourishing tree planted near the stream producing green leaves and fruit. In the gospel Luke presents an image - one that is opposed to that which the world teaches: that it is the poor and needy who are truly blessed. He tells us who is present at this gathering; the newly formed twelve apostles as well as many other disciples who had witnessed the miracles and healings Jesus had performed. With them were many who were simply curious. Luke is interested in the lived experience of those who are present: those who are physically poor, hungry, suffering. It is they who are marginalized by the society of the day, and they to whom this sermon brings very specific good news. Those people in power are however threatened by Jesus' message which challenges the very things that society regards as essential to happiness.

The things that we think we need to be happy and successful are exposed as being of no value at all in God's economy. What does the church teach us about worldly wealth and the responsibilities required of those who have an abundance of it? The social justice teachings of the church have been consistently forthcoming in the past hundred years. They remind us that the teachings of Jesus were not just for that time, but for all time.

Jesus is addressing us with the challenge of this teaching. How does this make you feel? Jesus did not say that it was wrong to own things, have enough to eat or a comfortable home, but his sermon reminds us that this should not be our sole focus in life.
