Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

In our first reading today, David chooses to spare his enemy from destruction. There is no hint of vengeance or hatred in the description of David's treatment of Saul. We only hear that David relies on God to reward those who are righteous and faithful. David's respect for the king is founded on the fact that, even with all of his faults, Saul is still the Lord's anointed. David's personal qualities are admirable. He does not take advantage of Saul's vulnerability. Instead, David offers forgiveness when his enemy is defenceless.

In our gospel lesus presents a remarkable vision of love, a vision that moves beyond loving only those who love us in return. Jesus challenges his followers to love their enemies and do good expecting little in return. Jesus tells us that God sets the standard of how we treat our enemies, and that standard includes acting with kindness mercy and forgiveness even to those we deem undeserving. This teaching was unconventional for its time and it continues to challenge followers of Jesus today.

lesus taught love of enemies with his actions as well as his words. lesus' entire life and ultimately his death modelled a self-giving love offered to all. Jesus offered forgiveness to the very ones who were persecuting him. The love and forgiveness that lesus extended was given freely for the salvation of all humanity. That is our challenge today, to put on the mind of Jesus, and trust in Him and love like Him!
