Feast of Christ the King

Today we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, or Christ the King. The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, formerly referred to as "Christ the King," was established by Pope Pius XI in 1925 as an antidote to secularism, a way of life which leaves God out of man's thinking and living and organizes his life as if God did not exist.

He recognized that attempting to "thrust Jesus Christ and his holy law" out of public life would result in continuing chaos among people and nations. It reminds us that while governments come and go, Christ reigns as King forever.

Pope Pius XI's encyclical gives Catholics hope and—while governments around us crumble—the assurance that Christ the King shall reign forever.

Today as a Church, we conclude our liturgical year. The Gospel we proclaim shows the great mystery of our faith: In the moment of his crucifixion, Jesus is shown to be King and Saviour of all.

Luke's Gospel has been loaded with surprises: the poor are rich, sinners find salvation, the Kingdom of God is found in our midst. Here we see the greatest surprise of all. We are confronted with the crucified Jesus, whom faith tells us is King and Saviour of all. The irony is that the inscription placed on the cross, perhaps in mockery, contains the profoundest of truth. As the leaders jeer, the thief crucified by his side recognizes Jesus as Messiah and King, and finds salvation.
