Holy Family Parish has purchased a Mitsubishi 4 x4 Jeep, which will be brought to Ukraine next month carrying medical aid and supplies for local hospitals. This will be part of a larger convoy of aid comprising of 8 jeeps and 2 ambulances, working alongside Irish Charity *PROJECT ESPWA* and an American/Ukrainian Charity *SUNFLOWER NETWORK*. Fr. Derek will drive this jeep across Northern Europe and all vehicles and supplies will be left in Ukraine.
