The Solemnity of Christ the King

To mark today's Solemnity of Christ the King, Evening Prayer and Benediction will be celebrated at our Cathedral of Christ the King in Mullingar today at 5pm. All parishioners from all over the diocese are most welcome to join.

Next Sunday we begin the Season of Advent; our time of preparation for Christmas. Therefore this Sunday marks the end of our current liturgical year.

Let's reflect upon Christ our King. When Jesus was asked by Pilate if he was a king, Jesus said that he was a king. Where are we to look for and find Jesus our king today?

Jesus is to be found in the hungry, the thirsty, the naked, the homeless, the poor, the rejected and those in prison. We are to turn our attention to each other if we are to find lesus.

Today's gospel asks us to draw closer and more intimately into Christ's presence who dwells within each of us. May we see and value Christ in others, especially those who are poor and those who are in any kind of need. This gospel is about each of us and how we follow lesus here and now.

lesus is a King and we are his brothers and sisters. Therefore we belong to a royal household. May we treat each other with the dignity and respect we deserve; as princes and princesses of a royal family.

As one of the early popes said, Christian, be aware of your dignity and nobility, it is God's own life that you share.

Sacrament of Confirmation 2019

Today we welcome the young people who are preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation at the 10:30 and 12:00 noon Masses.

Pope Francis addressing children preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation: A boy named Davide asked the pope, "When you were our age, what helped your friendship with lesus grow?"

First of all, the pope said, it was his grandparents. One of his grandfathers was a carpenter, who told him Jesus learned carpentry from St. Joseph, so whenever he saw his grandfather work, he thought of Jesus. The other grandfather taught him to always say something to lesus before going to sleep, even if it was just, "Good night, Jesus."

His grandmothers and his mother, were the ones who taught him to pray. He told the children that even if their grandparents "don't know how to use a computer or have a smartphone," they have a lot to teach them.

Going to Mass strengthened his faith because "being with others is important." He also encouraged families to go to Mass together. "This is beautiful and will help you live the commandment to keep the Lord's day holy."

An essential part of handing on the faith, he said, is teaching children the meaning of solidarity and engaging them in the parents' acts of charity and solidarity with the poor. "Faith grows with charity and charity grows with faith," he said.


St Mary's Roof Restoration Fundraiser 2019
