Solemnity of All Saints

On Thursday 1st November we will celebrate the Solemnity of All Saints. Holy Masses will be offered at 8am and at 8pm. We are called to become saints. All saints glorify God in heaven. We are fully alive when we glorify God. Our relationships with the saints should intensify our relationship with God. Saints are Christian men and women who distinguished themselves by dedicating their lives to loving and serving Almighty God and those whom they meet.

When we venerate a saint, we acknowledge and proclaim the victorious grace of Christ at work in a holy person's life. Saints are celebrated according to their distinction in life. Thus, the Litany of Saints distinguishes angels, patriarchs, prophets, apostles, evangelists, martyrs, bishops, confessors, priests, monks, hermits, virgins and widows.

Many lay people are becoming saints, with Saints Louis and Zelie Martin, whom Pope Francis canonized, reminding us that married people are called, commissioned and consecrated to become saints, and are duty bound to bring one another and their children to heaven.

All Souls' Day

On Friday 2nd November we will commemorate all of our Faithful Departed. St Ambrose reminds us that: "death is the end of earthly life, but not of our existence, since our souls are immortal."

Therefore on this day, we pray especially for all the souls in purgatory.

The preface of the Roman Missal reads: "For your faithful, O Lord, life has changed not ended; while our earthly dwelling is destroyed, a new and eternal dwelling is prepared for us in heaven." 2 Maccabees 12:46 informs us that: "It is... a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins."

Death is the passage into the fullness of true life. Our belief in the resurrection of Christ and in our future sharing in the glory of God is a key pillar of our faith. In baptism, we die to Christ, and from our baptism we are all called to deepen our intimacy with God, as we strive to be faithful followers of God, of his Word and of his way – by being doers of his will.

We pray for all the faithful departed of our parish, for all the souls buried in Calvary cemetery, for our families, friends, neighbours and all who died recently, may they rest in peace, Amen.
