Very Rev Gerry Rice, PE RIP

Fr Rice was born in St. Mary's Villas, Drogheda on 23 May 1937 and was educated in St Finian's College, Mullingar and St. Patrick's College, Maynooth. He was ordained on 18 June 1961 in St Patrick's College. The first seven years

of his priesthood were spent in the Diocese of Ossory, as Chaplain to the De La Salle Monastery in Castletown (Portlaoise) and then as a curate in St Patrick's parish (Kilkenny). He was appointed to the staff of St Patrick's Classical School in Navan where he taught English and History until 1986. Fr Rice was appointed Principal of St Mary's Diocesan School, Drogheda in 1986 until 1994. In September 1995, he was appointed Parish Priest of Kilcloon. Fr Rice celebrated his Golden Jubilee in June 2011 and

retired from active ministry in September 2011. He resided at Moyglare Nursing Home since September 2013 and died peacefully there on 22 August 2020. **May he rest in peace.**

The return to the public celebration of Mass and the Sacraments commenced on June 29th. This is a source of joy and hope to our parish community. Morning Mass has resumed at 8:00am. The weekend Masses will be as normal. We have installed a loudspeaker in the car park.

» A COVID-19 SUPPORT TEAM is established in the parish

- » The dispensation from the Sunday and Holy Day obligation is extended for the time being. Many parishioners may wish to attend Mass on a week-day rather than at weekends.
- » Hand sanitizers are in place **permanently** at each entrance to the church.

Please follow Health Guidelines and wear face masks.

- » Signs are in place to designate every second seat for use and for maintaining physical (social) distancing.
- » **Ushers** have been recruited to direct people to available seats including exit from the church, using the one-way system.
- » Thorough **cleaning** of church seats and other surfaces continues. Church seats will be cleaned with approved **sanitizing spray**.
- »Collection baskets will not be passed along during Masses; supervised collection baskets will be available at the church doors.
- » Ministers of the **Word** will be seated in their own seats, rather than the sacristy before Masses.
- » Ministers of Holy Communion will not be required to sign-in before Masses.
- » Communion should be received only on the hand.
- » Priests and Ministers of Holy Communion should visibly sanitize their hands before and after distribution of Holy Communion. Priests and Ministers should wear a face mask for the distribution of Holy Communion.
- » In the absence of choirs, **music ministry** will continue with a rota of instrumentalists and cantors as heretofore since Easter.
- » People attending Sunday Mass are encouraged to take the weekly bulletin home with them.
- » Altar servers will be able to maintain physical distancing in the sacristy and sanctuary.

 Offertory procession and Sign of Peace will be omitted..
- >>In light of the above directives, we would ask parishioners **not to gather** at the entrances to the church before or after Mass.

Baptisms have resumed. Anyone wishing to book a baptism can do so by calling the Parish Office.

Dates have been set aside in September for the children receiving their **First Holy Communion**.
