

Rest in Peace Pope Francis - In his statement following the death of Pope Francis on Easter Monday, Bishop Tom Deenihan expressed his profound sadness and shock at the Pope's passing, especially after his recent public appearances. He spoke of the Pope's humility, compassion and courage and how he lived up to his name 'Francis' - a name which desired to put the poor, the marginalised, fraternity and 'Sister Earth' at the centre of his Papacy. Bishop Deenihan joins with the priests, religious and people of the Diocese of Meath in praying for his soul.

Bishop Deenihan commended Pope Francis's legacy as a shepherd who bore the burdens of interceding for and anointing his people. He called upon the faithful to pray for the Pope's soul during the nine-day period of mourning, the Novemdiales.

The Bishop will celebrate Mass for the repose of the soul of Pope Francis on Tuesday 29th April in the Cathedral of Christ the King, Mullingar at 7.30pm. All are welcome to attend. Heavenly Father, we commend to Your Mercy our Holy Father, Pope Francis. May he enter into the eternal joy prepared for those who love you. Through Christ our Lord. Amen.
