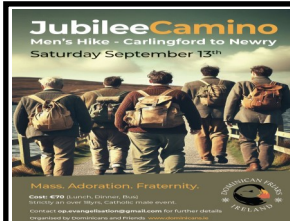
"With Mary Pilgrims of Hope" 2025 Jubilee Year
