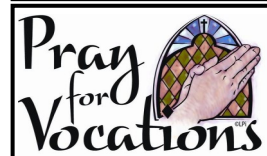

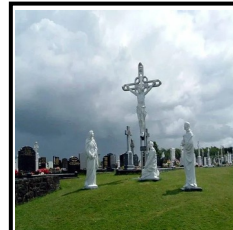
Come and spend some quiet time in prayer and reflection in the presence of Our Lord.
